HOUSE BILL 11

- 1 (1) A DIESEL-POWERED VEHICLE THAT DISCHARGES VISIBLE 2 EXHAUST AS THE RESULT OF NORMAL ACCELERATION OR TOWING;
- $_{\rm 3}$ (2) A commercial vehicle with a gross weight of 10,000 $_{\rm 4}$ pounds or more; or
- 5 (3) A CONSTRUCTION VEHICLE OPERATING AT A CONSTRUCTION 6 SITE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2017.
